

Remarks on board brig F A Bristow

Sat. March 25

this day beginning with lite breeze from W^NW and fog steering W^NW and middle part calm hands employed rigging boats

Sun March 26

this day beginning with lite breeze from S^E and fog and later part fresh breeze steering S^WW all sails set

Mon March 27

this day beginning with rain squalls wind S^E steering S^WW fresh breeze and at eleven A^M wind shifted to N^W at four P^M hall to S and steady rain rigging last boat heading W^SW on port tack

Tues March 28

this day beginning with wind from N^W rain and strong breeze steering W^SW

Wed March 29

this day beginning with wind from N^W steering W^SW and middle part calm and served out slops and to work in rigging and at four P^M wind sprang up from S steering W^SW

Thu March 30

this day beginning wind from S^E at twelve wind hall to E^NE steering W^SW all sail set and turned the boats over and over hauled foot rops so ends this day

Fri March 31

this day being with wind from E^NE steering W^SW all sail set hands employed taring down rigging and set up four tops as rigging ends day

Sat April 1

this day being with lite breeze from E^NE steering W^SW all sail set and past one steamer hands employed ship duty

Sun April 2

this day beginning with lite breeze from E^NE steering W^SW at twelve steering W^SW all sail set at four P^M calm

Mon April 3

this day beginning with wind from S^EW and at six A^M hall to W^SW heading N^W by the wind on the port tack all sail set hands employed ship duty

Tues April 4

this day being with lite breeze from N^WW steering W^SW all sail set hands employed in ship duty

Wed April 5

day beginning with rain squalls at twelve clear off wind from E^NE steering W^SW and good breeze hands employed ship duty

Thu April 6

the day being with wind E steering W^SW all sail set and brok out provisions and hand employed ship duty
