

Remarks on Board Brig F. A. Boston

Fri April 7

this day being with lite breeze from E steering Wb N and at seven A M after our course to W N W all sail set hands employed repairing sails

Sat April 8

this being with lite breeze from N b E and steering W N W and later part steering N W b W all sail set hands employed repair sails

Sun April 9

this day being with lite breeze from S b E steering N W b W all sail set

Mon April 10

this day being with rain squalls and wind from S and at ten A M wind hall to E and clear steer N W b W hands employed repair sails

Tues April 11

this day beginning with rain squalls first part of the day and wind hall from E to S lite breeze steering N W b W all sail set hands employed repair sails

Wen April 12

this day beginning with calm at six A M wind spring up from N b E and at eight A M hall to N E and strong breeze and rain all day steering N W b W

Thurs April 13

this day being with rain all day and wind from N E steering N W b W all sail set

Fri April 14

this day being with lite breeze from N E b N and first part of day steering N W b W and later part steering N W b N

Sat April 15

this day being with lite breeze from S W steering N W b W all sail set hands employed ship duty

Sun April 16

this day being with wind from W b N heading N b W by the wind on port tack

Mon April 17

this day being with lite breeze from N W steering by the wind on port tack and at seven A M wore ship heading W b S on starb tack and last part calm hands employed ship duty

Tues April 18

day beginning calm and at nine A M wind spring up from S b E and thick and rain steering N W b N all sail set and repair main top stails

Wen April 19

this day beginning wind from W S W and steering N W b N and rain by spells all day and at five P M wind hall to N W steering by the wind on port tack
