This day being Thru April 20
this day being with strong breeze
N W b W and laying to under
short sail on port tack

Fri April 21

day beginning with calm at seven A M
breeze sprung up from S E and thick snow
storm and steering N W at four
P M wind hall to S W and clear off

Sat April 22

This day beginning calm at seven A M
light breeze from S E steering N W and
at seven wind hall to N and breeze
up strong and snow squalls and on
the starboard tack under short sail

Sun April 23

day being with strong breeze from W N W
heading N laying to under storm
stails on port tack wather heavy

Mon April 24

This day beginning wind from W N W
heading N on port tack all sail set
and last part calm

Tues April 25

day commences with strong breeze N E b E
and thick snow storm and laying to
on port tack under storm stails and
later wind hall to E and dying out
fast and thick fog and heading
S E b E still on port tack

Wed April 26

This day beginning wind from N W
and first part foggy and later part
snow by spells and first part heading
to southward and westward by the wind
and last part heading northward and east

Thru April 27

day beginning with light breeze from
W heading N N W by wind on port
tack raised land at six A M and
last part calm and small island
in sight to north and west of us and
the nearest land about twenty miles

Fri April 28

day commences wind from W and foggy by
spells and working to westward along the
land at seven P M distance from land
twelve miles land ahead and wather bow

Sat April 29

This commences with light breeze from W S W
and foggy by spells and N W steering
and spoke brig mizzen and being in
42 pas and not quite threw land
bearing S W one island and the other
bearing E and very light air from S

Sun April 30

day commences with wind from E N E and
at three P M hall to N E b N steering
N W b N all sail set and the
brig mizzen in sight to north of us
and turned one boat side side up
