

Remarks on board S. A. Baston

Mon May 1
day being with lite breeze from NNW
heading W on starb. tack and put
up crew next up and turned waist
and larb bot rite side up

Tues May 2
day being with lite breeze from E and
at five P M wind fell to SE steering
NNW and bent new boat sails

Wen May 3
this day being with lite breeze from NE
steering NNW and shifted four top
sails and focal and head sails

Thu May 4
this day being with wind from NN E
heading NW by the wind at seven A M
raised ice and to steamer in site
and working threw the ice to NW
and later part rais brig and scooner

Frid May 5
this day being with lite breeze from
N to NW and working to westward
threw scarted ice and one steamer
in site and gamed the brig miss
and scooner rosario

Sat May 6
this day being with lite breeze from S and
working to westward and northward threw
scarted ice and one scooner and brig
in site and at 4 P M calm at eight
P M lite breeze sprung up from N

Sun May 7
this day being with lite breeze from S
and working to NW threw scarted ice
and middle part calm later part wind
sprang up from W to S and three sails
in site and heading NW by port tack

Mon May 8
day beginning with wind from SW by W
heading NW along the ice and at 4 P M
took the ice and last part calm
and scooner and brig in site

Tue May 9
this day beginning with calm and thick
fog and in the ice at five P M wind
sprang up from S W and cleared off and
steering SE threw ice and soon got
in clear water brig and scooner in site

Wen May 10
this day being with wind from W and
last part along strong and laying
along the ice under short sail and
scooner and brig in site and land
in site to NW of us

Thu May 11
day being with lite breeze from E and
to vessels in site to west of us and board
for bowhead and larb boat struck
bot along side at 4 P M and took
the head and at four P M board starb
boat struck a bowhead and took
him along side at five the same day
and in the scarted ice
