

Remarks on board brig To Bastow
 Fri May 12

This day being with lite breeze from E
 and in the ice and at two thirty
 A. M. our seton wail and finish cut
 at five A. M. and scooner and brig
 in site and land to north off
 us and saw bowhead but no chance
 to load a boat ice too thick for boat

Sat May 13

This day being with lite breeze from E
 and work out of the ice into clear
 water and saw several bowheads and
 they going quick into N E and
 we load twice but fail to get any
 and land in site and scooner
 and brig miss biling

Sun May 14

day commences with wind from N and
 snow little and spoke brig miss
 and scooner roiser and laying around
 the ice and saw miss strike whail
 but lost him but she found dead
 whail and we load our boats but
 turned out to bea killers land site

Mon May 15

day being with strong breeze from
 N W and working to N threw
 strips of ice and snow at seven
 P M clear off and four vessels in
 site and at eight P M load for
 bowhead but did not get any
 and land in site to W of us
 and saw scooner roiser load
 for bowhead

day commences with wind from N W
 and working to N first part of the day
 and last part calm and saw brig miss
 take a bowhead and scooner and steamer
 in site and land in site and in
 monce strips of ice

Wed May 17

day being with lite breeze from
 W N W and working to N threw
 the ice and last part calm
 and brig in stand spoke and scooner
 in site and land in site to
 N W and W and the biling

Thu May 18

day commences with calm and last part
 lite breeze from E S E and working
 to N E threw the ice and gambled
 the scooner roiser brig miss in
 site and land in site to N W

Fri May 19

day commences with lite breeze from N E
 and working to N E threw ice and
 middle part calm at four P M wind
 sprung up from W S W at seven P M
 got out in clear water steering E N E
 land in site to W and W of us and
 brig and scooner in site

Sat May 20

commences with lite breeze from S W and
 working to S W along the ice at four P M
 load to boats for bowhead and in come
 scooner roiser and land in site
 and brig miss and spoke scooner brig
