Fri May 30

comences with lite breeze from NE and middle part calm at four P M wind fall to W and working to NE threw ice and seven sails in site and land in site to NW of us distance from land 30 miles and pack our box on deck on cont of rats

Wed May 31

comences with lite breeze from W working to NE threw ice and fifteen sails in site all working the same way land in site to NW of us at eleven A M shet in thick fog and toft to aback short sail at one P M cept of and working to NE at four P M we got in to heavy ice and took in all sail made fast to the ice

Thu June 1

comences with wind from SW and thick fog and still fast to the ice and saw brig merr in the ice

Fri June 2

comences with lite breeze from E and last part blong strong from E NE and three sails in site fast in the ice and snow by spells and we being fast to the ice and first part foggy

Sat June 3

day being with strong breeze from NW W and six sails in site and all fast in the ice but one and we are tide up to ice and land in site to NW of us and snow by spells

Sun June 4

day comences with wind from NW and middle part wind fall to SW and snow by spells at four P M let go of the ice and made sail and working threw the ice to E NE and six sails in site and land in site to NW of us

Mon June 5

day being with lite breeze W S W and later part hally to E S E and working to N N E threw the ice and land in site and first part five sails in site and last part four all working the same

Tues June 6

comences with wind from N E S E and thick snow storm and work to N threw the ice at ten A M took in sail and laying back at one clear off and made sail and working to north still and one sail set and spork bark James allen and snow still
