

Remarkson Board Brig F. A. Boston
 Fri. Jun 16

commences with strong breeze from
 S.W. heading S.E. by wind start
 tack and later part the day lite
 breeze from S.W. and steering
 N.W. and ran to lawarance
 island baring S and inclin.
 pin baring N.W. and some
 ice around and heavy by spells

Sat. Jun 17

being with calm all day and land
 in site to west of us and few ships
 of ice in site to north and N.W. and
 last part thick fog

Sun Jun 18

commences with lite breeze from N
 heading E. N.E. on port tack at
 twelve took in lit sails at seven
 P.M. wind shift to N.W. and clear
 off raised King island baring
 N.W. and heading N.E.

Mon Jun 19

commences with wind from N.W.
 at seven A.M. wind to S.W. and
 being off King island and lot
 of natives come on board last part
 wearing N.E. lite breeze and raining

Tue Jun 20

being strong breeze from N.W. laying
 to anchor at mouth of port of Orange
 and washed bone and three sails
 to anchor and to steamer at seven
 P.M. got under way shifted to the
 san spit

Mon Jun 21

commences with calm at nine A.M.
 wind from N.W. and shifted little
 near noon the san spit by wind
 left to us and anchor hands
 employed shift drying bone
 and boiling bone and seal steam-
 ers anchor at the san spit

Tue Jun 22

commences with lite breeze from N.E.
 and shifted twice on count of ice
 and seal sailing vessels laying to
 anchor at the san spit and seal
 steamers at the point at four P.M.
 the fair came to anchor and a
 officer came on board and had
 his employed setting shuckes

Fri Jun 23

being with lite breeze S.W. and last
 part thick fog and calm day to
 anchor at the san spit and sailing
 vessel came to anchor load with coal
 and hired a cooper to flag cask for
 water

Sat Jun 24

commences with calm and thick fog
 and middle part clear off lite
 breeze from S. and being to anchor
 to west of the san spit at three
 P.M. got under way and anchor
 to E. of the san spit and some
 ice around hands employed
 ship duty
