

Remarks on board *C. A. V. Bastow*

Sun Jun 25
commences with wind from S S E
and thick fog and last part blowing
strong and drop our section anchor
and clear off a little and see ten
ships and steamers laying to
anchor at the sand spit

Mon Jun 26
being with strong breeze from S S E
and middle part lite breeze at four
P M wind hall to N N W and blowing
strong and rain all day laying to an-
chor at the sand spit

Tues Jun 27
commences with wind from W and
last part wind from S still at
the sand spit and smoke of ships
and late in the evening the gine
came to anchor at the sand spit

Wed Jun 28
commences with lite breeze from S S E
and foggy by spells and later part
rain and got some of our mail from
the gine at the water place

Thurs Saty Jun 29
commences with calm and middle
part calm and rain and last
part lite breeze from S thick
fog

Fri Jun 30
commences with thick fog and calm
and middle part calm clear off
a little and we got our stuff from
the tender for box of potatoes
and three barrels of onions and box
of eggs and last part rain

Sat July 1
commences with lite breeze from N at eight
A M got under way and went to the
water place and anchor at three P M
and sent raft shore

Sun July 2
commences calm and rain and got
threw watering at eleven A M and
took our anchor and took off shore
a little mail

Mon July 3
commences with strong breeze from S
and rain at five A M took our anchor
came over to the sand spit and
anchor at seven A M and the steamer
burtha came in to anchor

Tues July 4
commences with rain wind from S and
last part wind from N and clear
off for a while and we put our
things aboard the steamer burtha
for by bundles
