

Remarks on Board Brig F. C. Baston

Sun July 30
 commences with wind from NE and thick fog at seven A M clear off a little and saw ice cape and head N N W all day at seven P M came to ice and wore ship heading E by S and still thick fog under short sail

Mon July 31
 commences with wind from NE and strong breeze and clear and working to N being on first one tack and the other saw land at three P M at four P M thick fog again under short sail

Tue Aug 1
 being with strong breeze from NE and heavy and standing in and off from the land and saw two schooners to anchor and scattering ice just clear the land at five P M being off rain rite inlet and sheet in thick fog heading of shore

Wen Aug 2
 commences with wind from NE at seven A M clear off and anchor to south of pint bilgom at nine shifted on count of ice at one got under way on count of ice and stood off shore at nine P M anchor again in strong breeze and some ice around and to schooners to anchor

Thu Aug 3
 being with strong breeze from NE and laying to anchor and getting wood and in the afternoon shifted along the beach twice and some ice round and to women laying to anchor

Fri Aug 4
 commences with wind from N N E and laying to anchor and boat shore getting wood at seven got under way and working to N and thick fog by spells and saw two schooners and few cakes of ice

Sat Aug 5
 commences with wind from N E and thick fog at eight A M clear off and rain land and anchor just to south of pint bilgom and to schooners and one bark laying to anchor and saw three masted schooner going to S and ground flow of ice at the pint hands in employe in getting wood

Sun Aug 6
 commences with thick fog at seven A M got under way and working to N and middle part of day clear and last part fog and two schooners and one bark working the same and strong breeze
