

Remarks on Board Brig F. A. Barton

Mon Aug 7

commences with wind from NE and thick fog and middle part clear working to N along the land and to scooper and one bark working the same at seven. P M come in thick fog and anchor just to north of refuge inlet and some ice in site off shore of us

Tues Aug 8

commences with thick fog and wind from NE at seven P M got under way working to N and middle part clear at six P M come in thick fog and we anchor at Cape Smith at ten P M got under way and work up to the pint at one anchor of the going station and several ships and steamers laying to pint and lot of ice in site

Wed Aug 9

being with thick fog by spells and wind from NE and laying at the pint and saw the bar going to the south

Thurs Aug 10

commences with clear and wind from NE and still laying at the pint hand employed ship duty and foggy by spells and drying sails

Fri Aug 11

being with strong breeze from NE and still laying at the pint angle let the bark Triton have a cask of beef and pork hand employed reperiing sails and shifted head sails

Sat Aug 12

commences with light breeze from NE and last part blowing strong and fixed our four staves and bent it and turned out few slops

Sun Aug 13

being with strong breeze from NE and plenty of ice to E of the pint and off shore of us and quite fleet laying at the pint

Mon Aug 14

being with strong breeze from NE and foggy by spells and hands employed in ship duty and saw William Bayles worked up from Cape Smith and brig

Tues Aug 15

commences with wind from NE and rain at twelve clear off at six P M got under way and work to N a little and anchor a little near the pint
