

Remarks on board brig *L. St. bartow*

Thu Aug 24

commences with wind from NE by E and clear steering from W to NW and saw some ice and three ships in sight and lashed our anchors up and stow our chain way

Fri Aug 25

commences with clear and wind from NE and steering from SW by W along the pack of ice and three sails in sight and shifted topsails and bent the new stails and lost part foggy

Sat Aug 26

commences wind from NE and fog and being by the wind on the port tack along the ice heading E by E at four P M clear off a little and spoke bark hunter and saw three other ships

Sun Aug 27

commences with light breeze from NE and rain and working to NE and saw three ships at twelve come in thick fog

Mon Aug 28

commences with wind from NE and fog at seven A M clear off heading to N all day at six P M back ship heading SE and spoke bark Alice Knowlton and bark Laker and light breeze

Tue Aug 29

commences with foggy by spells and wind from NE by E heading to N about all day light wind and gained the bark bound bills and saw no other ship to N of us

Wed Aug 30

this day being with wind from E by NE and foggy by spells all threw the day and to ships in sight and ice in sight working to NE and gained the bark Laker and Alice Knowlton

Thu Aug 31

commences with fog wind from NE by E heading N by the wind in the morning at eight A M raise the ice and clear off steering SW and one ship in sight

Fri Sept 1

commences with light breeze from E by NE heading to S first part of day at seven A M rain and thick and spoke bark John Winthrop and brig merr and saw another ship heading N last part of the day

Sat Sept 2

commences with wind from NE and weather thick by spells and steering SW and gained the brig Blakey and saw eight other ships and saw ice to S W of us
