

Remarks on Board Brig F. A. Bastow

Wed Sept 13

comences with weather clear at six A M saw a bowhead but never saw him but once and saw seal ships and middle the four none come in thick fog and heading to N W first part of day and last part heading E wind being N E and saw some ice

Thu Sept 14

comences with calm and thick fog at eight A M clear off lite breeze from S E and working to E along the ice and seal sails in site and spoke bark hunter and brig mirt

Fri Sept 15

comences with wind from E S E and snow and steering S W at eight A M left to heading S and rain the rest of the day and saw seal ships and ice in site in the morning and spoke bark northern light

Sat Sept 16

comences with wind from E S and rain at seven A M wind half to W and left off steering N E and to vesles in site at four P M left to heading to N W at dark shorten sail and snow by spells

Sun Sept 17

being with wind from S and heavy heading W S W last part thick fog and calm

Mon Sept 18

being with wind from S W to W and snow by spells all day and first part of day heading S S W and last part heading W N W and to vesles in site

Tue Sept 19

comences with wind from W and snow by spells first part of day heading S S W and last part heading N at three P M lost for a bowhead but never saw him aft we loosed and four sails in site and the island in site to west of us

Wed Sept 20

comences with lite breeze from W and middle part calm last part lite air from E and the island bearing W S W and seal vesles in site and some scattering ice and gameot the steamer Albatross and brig his dilgo
