Thu Sept 21

commences with wind from E. N. E. and clear and some ice in site and number of ships in site and last part thick fog and gained the James Arnold and working to N. E.

Fri Sept 22

being with wind from E. N. E. and weather thick snow by spells all thren the day first part of day heading S. E. and last part heading N. and saw several sails and lite bears all day

Sat Sept 23

commences with lite bears from E. N. E. and working to E. and last part strong bears and clear and number of vessels in site

Sun Sept 24

commences with lite bears from E. N. E. and lite bears and middle part calm and number sails in site and steam and gained all ice knows

Mon Sept 25

commences with lite bears from N. E. and snow by spells and steering S. and last part good bears and thick snow storm and one ship with boats down and spork scooper fair gray at five P. M. left heading E. short sail

being with wind from N. E. and first part of day steering S. W. and last part steering S. W. by W. and one ship in site at dark shorten sail heading N. W.

Wed Sept 27

commences with thick snow storm and middle and last part clear by spells wind from N. first part of day steering S. W. at noon left heading W. N. W.

Thu Sept 28

being with wind from N. and heading E. N. E. on port tack at six A. M. is land in site bearing N. and snow by spells all day

Fri Sept 29

being with wind from N. E. to N. and heading from N. N. W. to W. N. W. and stormy all day and saw three sails and fresh bears

Sat Sept 30

commences with fresh bears from N. N. E. and working to N. E. and thick snow storm by spells and saw three sails
