Tue Oct 14
commences with lite breeze from NW
steering SE. b. Sand snow by spells
one sail in site at dark shorten
sail and steering SSE

Wen Oct 18
being with lite breeze from NW
at daylight steering SE and
at noon being off point
at dark steering SE. b. with very
lite breeze and one sail in site

Thur Oct 19
commences with wind from S. b. W
at daylight being off point George
on the wind start back at dark
wind hall to S with fresh breeze
heading ESE and one sail in site

Fri Oct 20
commences with wind from S and
heading WSW on the wind on
port tack with fresh breeze at
dark blow a corn of gail from
S laying to on storm stails

Sat Oct 21
commences with strong breeze from S
heading W b. S with storm stails
at dark wind hall to SSE and
more ship heading SE short sail

commences with wind from S b. W

Mon Oct 23

hall to W and steering SE and
section mate come on duty today
and sent down coaling gear

Tue Oct 24
commences with fresh breeze from N
steering S at noon wind hall to
NE and steering SE at 10 thirty
P. M. pass land at dark going in
to seventy to pass with a good
breeze land on our port beam about
twelve miles off

Wen Oct 25
being with calm all day hands im-
ployed ship duty and sent down
our croc nest

Thur Oct 26
commences with lite breeze from SE. b.
E heading S by the wind at twelve
commence to rain and wind hall to
at dark strong breeze from ESE
under short sail
