Fri Oct 24

commences with strong breeze from N and rain steering E. & S at noon have to making bad work of running and gail from N and saw one steamer

Sat Oct 28

commences with fresh breeze from N. W at seven A. M. kept off E. & S at noon wind mording fast at dark calm

Sun Oct 29

being with wind from S. S. E. and steering E. with all sail set

Mon Oct 30

commences with wind from S. S. E. steering E. little breeze at noon wind hall to S. E. heading E. N. E. at dark calm and rain a little by spells

Tue Oct 31

commences with wind from S. E. at seven A. M. hall to S. and thick fog steering E. & S

Nov Mon 1

being with wind from S. & W. thick fog and rain by spells all day and steering E. & S. ten A. M. steering E. with fresh breeze

Nov Thu 2

commences with wind from S. W. and thick wither at seven A. M. wind hall to W. & N. steering E. & S. and clear by spells with good breeze

Nov Fri 3

being with little breeze from W. and few rain squalls steering E. & S

Nov Sat 4

commences with fresh breeze from S. S. W. at noon, commences to rain and wind hall to W. steering E. & S. with hool to sail and focal

Nov Sun 5

commences with fresh breeze from S. S. W. at ten A. M. commences to rain and heavy squalls and steering E. and then squalls steering E. & N. at noon hoar to sail and focal blowing strong and one sail in site

commences with strong breeze from S. W. and squall steering E. & N. hoar to sail and real focal at seven A. M. wind hall to W. and rain hard steering E. at one P. M. clear off
