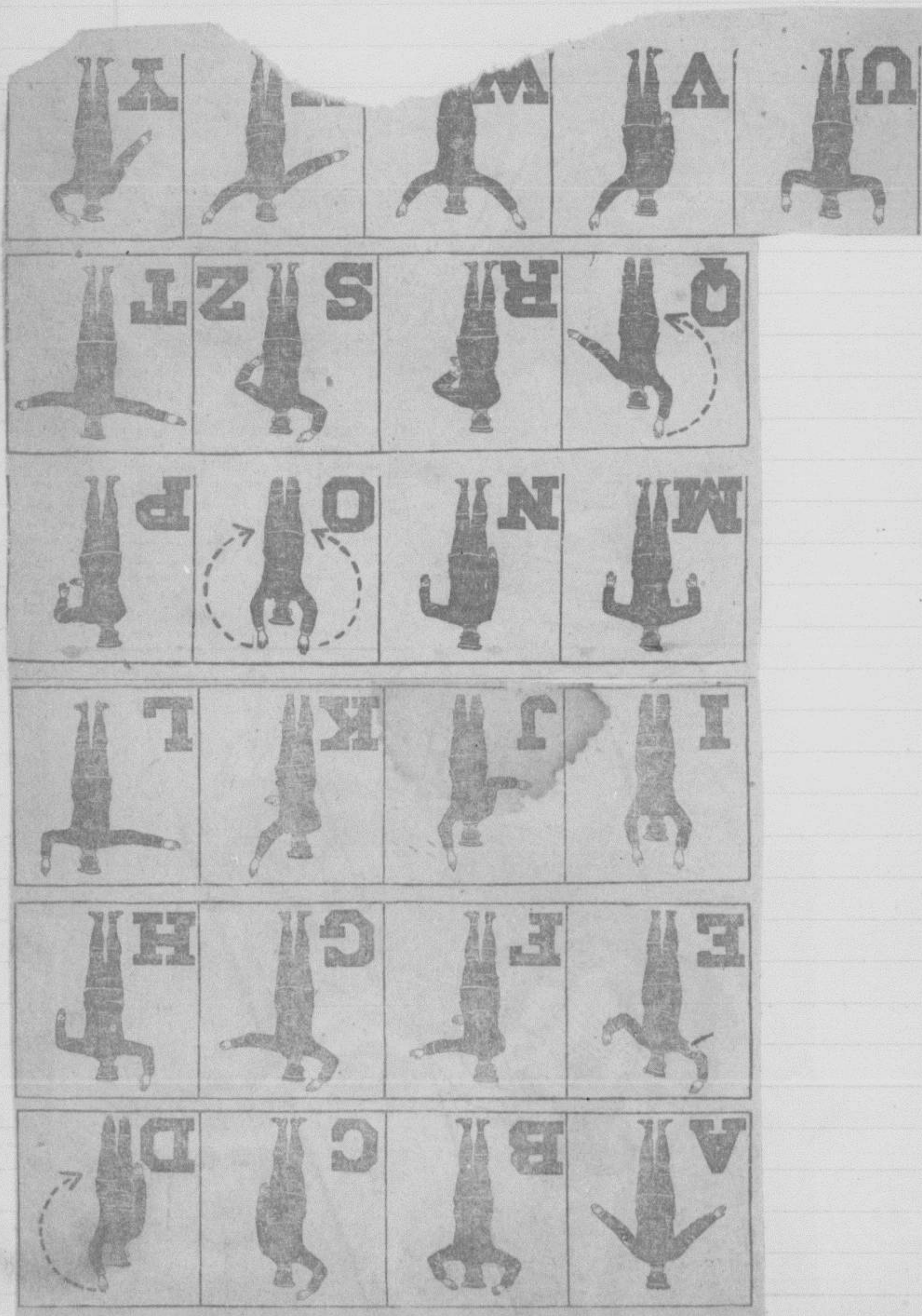




TO SIGNAL WITH A HUMAN ALPHABET.
