Begins with a fine breeze from N.W. heading N.E. by the wind middle and last part wind W steering N.W. by N under all sail fog and icebergs

Tuesday Aug 3rd

Begins with a fresh breeze from S.W. steering N.W. by N under all sail thick fog middle part light airs and calm last part fine breeze from W.S.W. steering S.W. by S under short sail trying to pick our way into Hudson Straits in a thick fog been passing icebergs all day at 2 P.M. came up to plenty of scattering

Tuesday Aug 3rd

ice wore ship heading off again took in Main sail and set try sail very thick fog and a heavy swell heaving in from the S.E.

Wednesday Aug 4th

Begins with clear weather with light baffling airs and calm with plenty of scattering ice around at daylight saw Resolution Island middle part off lower Savages last part steering N with light airs for middle Savages

Thursday Aug 5th

Begins with clear weather with light baffling airs and calm middle and last part the same drifting along the land towards the middle savages at 6 P.M. lowered the Starboard Boat and went on shore

Begins with a calm and a thick fog drifting with the tide middle part light breeze from the W heading along the coast at 2 P.M. hauled aback of middle savages looking for natives but found none last part fine breeze from N.W. on different tacks working up the coast
