Begins with clear weather and a fine breeze from W. working towards whale point at 7 AM. lowered the Starboard Boat and went on shore but found no natives at 11.30 came on board and worked to the N at 1 P.M. saw some tents on the beach lowered the Boat and went on shore but found no natives but see tracks of the Era's natives they having left there a few days before for there were fresh scrapings of bone from 2 whales Boat came on board at 2.30 P.M. commenced working tack and tack for Cape Pulerton } last part the same

Monday Aug 23<sup>rd</sup>

Begins with fine weather fine weather and a fine breeze from S.W. heading by the wind on different tacks middle part the same last part laying off and on Cape Pulerton.

Tuesday Aug 24<sup>th</sup>

Begins with hazy weather and a strong breeze from S.W. laying off and on Cape Pulerton at 6.30 A.M. came to an anchor off the Cape last part laying at anchor. lowered 3 Boats and rounded out the harbor

in 16 fathoms of water

Wednesday Aug 25<sup>th</sup>

Begins with thick weather and blowing hard from S.W. laying at anchor at 6.30 A.M. let go the second anchor at 10.30 A.M. The Starboard Boat went on shore middle part the same last part moderate breeze from S.W. with thick fog

Thursday Aug 26<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a moderate breeze from N.E. with fog and rain at day light commenced to blow from N.E. middle and last part moderate at 4 P.M. Boat came on board from shore

Friday Aug 27<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fine weather and a light breeze from E.N.E. laying at anchor waiting for tide to turn to get under weigh middle and last part breezing on from E.N.E. still laying at anchor weather looking bad

Saturday Aug 28<sup>th</sup>

This 24 hours blowing hard from E.N.E. with fog and rain laying under Cape Pulerton with two anchors down
