

Sunday Aug 29th
This 24 hours laying at anchor
under Cape Pulerton wind bound
wind E.

Monday Aug 30th
Begins with clear weather and
a fresh breeze from E.N.E. at
daylight took our anchor and
stood out in the Bay at 8 A.M.
commenced to breeze on doubled
reefed the Fore and Main sails
and stood in for Cape Pulerton
at 11.30 A.M. came to an anchor
in 9 fathoms of water last part
fresh breeze from E.N.E. at anchor
Broke out the after hole

Tuesday Aug 31st
Begins with a fresh breeze from
N.E. at anchor middle and last
part the same Starboard Boat went
on shore

Wednesday Sept 1st
First part calm laying at anchor
middle part light breeze from
W.S.W. at 1 P.M. took our anchor
and stood out in the Bay at
3 P.M. raised a sail to the Eastward
of us call it the Era with 3 Boats
down at 10 P.M. one of the 3 Boats
came on board turned out to be
3 natives Boats last part calm

Thursday Sept 2nd
Begins with hazy weather and
a light breeze from S at daylight
sent the Starboard Boat on shore
and got 3 natives at 6 A.M. spoke
the Sch Era. at 8 A.M. kept off
for Repulse Bay at 11 A.M. saw
a Bowhead lowered 3 Boats without
success at 5 P.M. kept off N.E. by N
under Foresail and Fore Stay sail
fresh breeze from S.W. hazy
weather Era in sight

Friday Sept 3rd
Begins with a fresh breeze from S.S.W.
with fog steering E.N.E. under Fore sail
and Fore Stay sail at 2.30 A.M. fog lit up
raised the land close to sound and got
9 fathoms of water wore ship off shore
aback untill daylight then kept off
N.W. & along the land middle part
calm with fog and rain last part
fresh breeze from N.N.W. and clear
heading on different tacks at 5 P.M.
carried away the Flying Jib Boom

Saturday Sept 4th
Begins with clear weather and a strong
breeze from N.N.W. heading on different
tacks under single reef sails middle
part the same at 3 P.M. came to
an anchor in Repulse Bay in 13 fathoms
of water saw some ice in the Bay
the Bark Platina and Perseverance
a Scotch Bark at anchor
saw a Bowhead did not lower
blowing strong

Saw a Bowhead
