 First calm middle and last part
 fresh breeze from S.E. with snow squalls
 lowered 2 Boats saw nothing finished
 stowing the hole

Sunday Sept 12th
 Begins with a strong gale from
 the N with snow did not lower
 the boats middle part the same
 last part fine weather employed
 in building a storage

Monday Sept 13th
 Begins with fine weather and a
 light breeze from N.W. at daylight
 the Platina and the Scotch Bark
 got underweigh bound home the
 Platina drifted on the point run
 a line to the Sch and hauled her
 off middle and last part fresh
 breeze from the S with a thick
 snow storm at 1 P.M. the Scotch
 Bark came to an anchor again
 lowered 2 Boats saw nothing

Tuesday Sept 14th
 Begins with a strong breeze
 from the S.E. with a thick snow
 storm middle part wind N
 with a strong breeze and clear
 at 8 A.M. the Scotch Bark got
 under weigh last part fine
 weather and a fine breeze from
 N.W. lowered 2 Boats
 saw 3 Bowheads
