

Monday Sept 27th

Begins with thick weather and a fresh gale from the S. did not lower the Boats employed in working on the house

Tuesday Sept 28th

Begins with clear weather and a strong breeze from W. saw a Bowhead one rising. Lowered 3 Boats but did not see him again

Wednesday Sept 29th

This 24 hours clear weather and blowing hard from the NW did not lower the Boats employed in working on the house

Thursday Sept 30th

This 24 hours N.W. wind first part fine lowered 3 Boats middle and last part strong breeze Boats came on board saw nothing

Friday Oct 1st

This 24 hours blowing strong from S.W. with snow did not lower the Boats finished the house and commenced cutting ice for the winter

Saw a Bowhead

Saturday Oct 2nd

This 24 hours fine weather and a fine breeze from the N 3 Boats cruising saw nothing

Sunday Oct 3rd

This 24 hours cloudy and blowing hard from the E did not lower the Boats at 5 P.M. let go the second anchor.

Monday Oct 4th

This 24 hours clear weather and blowing heavy from the N lowered no Boats. 2 anchors down

Tuesday Oct 5th

This 24 hours clear weather and blowing from the N 2 anchors down plenty of young ice at 3 P.M. moderated some one Boats crew went on shore and commenced to cut ice for winter use

Wednesday Oct 6th

This 24 hours fine weather and a fine breeze from NW plenty of young ice did not lower the Boats finished cutting ice and so on.
