

Monday May 2nd

This 24 hours cloudy and a fresh breeze from the N.W.

Sch came up out of her bed in the ice and raised about one foot and Therm 24 above commenced to leak immediately at the rate of 33200 strokes in 24 hours

Tuesday May 3rd

This 24 hours fine weather Sch leaking the same Broke out the hole and tried to find the leak but did not succeed Put on shore 4 Cask Bread one Flour 4th Pork 2 Tierces Molasses and one Cask Beef at 5 P.M. Divided the crew into 4 watches of 3 hours each

Wednesday May 4th

This 24 hours clear and a fresh breeze from the N.W. employed in getting provisions, wood, and coal on shore and trying to find the leak at last found one place under the Fore castle where the Garboard had started Sch leaking 34200 strokes in 24 hours

Thursday May 5th

This 24 hours thick and blowing a gale from the N.W.
Sch leaking about the same

Friday May 6th

This 24 hours clear and blowing a gale from the N.W. Sch frozen in again Therm zero Leak decreasing a little, leaking about 24000 strokes in 24 hours

Saturday May 7th

This 24 hours clear and a fresh breeze from the N.W.
Sch leaking the same
Therm 10 above

Sunday May 8th

This 24 hours clear and a light breeze from the N.W.
Sch leaking the same
Therm 2 below zero

Monday May 9th

This 24 hours clear and calm leaking the same - sent 2 natives to Cape Fulerton.

Tuesday May 10th

This 24 hours clear and a light breeze from the N.W.
Leak the same Therm 10 above
Got the Boats from shore and commenced to get the Starboard Boat ready for whaling.
