

Wednesday Aug 24th

Bowhead

This 24 hours fine with variable winds put Edward Murray the Ship Keeper in as Boat steerer and the Boat started after 2nd and 3rd mates, got there and the Capt struck one and got him

Thursday Aug 25th

This 24 hours hazy with S.W. winds Capt returned from Blue Lands after having hauled the whale on the beach left 2nd and 3rd mate to cut him

Monday Aug 29th

Fine weather with light N winds 2nd and 3rd mate came from Blue Lands with bone from the whale

Wednesday Aug 31st

This 24 hours clear and a light breeze from the S. got the Beh under weigh and went to the Blue Lands anchored in 15 fathoms of water

Thursday Sept 1st

This 24 hours clear with variable winds Mate returned from Cork Bay saw whales once

Friday Sept 2nd

This 24 hours clear with light N.W. Boats cruising 7 in all

Saturday Sept 3rd

Same as above

Sunday Sept 4th

This 24 hours fine weather and a light breeze from the W at 6 A.M. got the Beh under weigh and cruised along the land

Monday Sept 5th

This 24 hours clear and a light breeze from the N.W. at 2.30. A.M. came to an anchor in 11 fathoms of water

Tuesday Sept 6th

This 24 hours light airs from the N.W. 5 Boats cruising at 7 A.M. took our anchor and started for the Islands for Ballast at 11 A.M. died out calm came to an anchor in 4 1/2 fathoms of water
