

Wednesday Sept 7th

This 24 hours fresh breeze from N.W. with snow squalls 4 Boats cruising at 6 A.M. took our anchor and started for the Islands at noon came to an anchor in 16 fathoms of water afternoon got of 6 load of stone

Thursday Sept 8th

This 24 hours clear and a fresh breeze from N.W. 3 Boats for the Head of the Bay 4 Boats cruising from S.W.

Friday Sept 10th

First part fresh breeze from N.W. 3 Boats got back from the Head of the Bay saw nothing last part blowing very hard from the N. At 5 P.M. let go 2^d anchor Paid of the natives

Sunday Sept 11

This 24 hours fresh breeze from the N.W. at 10.30. 2 M took our anchor and started for Cape Filerter at 6 P.M. came to an anchor in Rose Welcome in 15 fathoms of water

Monday Sept 12th

This 24 hours blowing very hard from the N.W. with very heavy snow squalls at 6.30 A.M. let go the 2^d anchor at 11.30 Port chain parted 37 fathoms from the anchor towards night moderated some laying with 120 fathoms of chain out at sun down hove in the chain to the 90 fathom shackle to the water

Tuesday Sept 13th

This 24 hours fine with light baffling winds working tack and tack took our anchor at 3.30 A.M.

Wednesday Sept 14th

This 24 hours cloudy with light baffling airs ~~from~~ working tack and tack

Thursday Sept 15th

This 24 hours snowing and blowing heavy from the N.E. laying in Rose Welcome under 2^d try sails and fore stay sail on tack and tack
