Begins with a strong breeze from W heading by the wind on the Southern tack under reef main sail and fore sail repaired jib top sail & steamers in sight

Sunday Oct 9th

Begins with a strong breeze from S.W. with rain heading on the Southern tack at 8 a.m. commenced to breeze at 9 a.m. took in every thing and set 2 reefed try sails last part more moderate set reefed fore sail, and jib

Monday Oct 10th

This 24 hours blowing a heavy gale from the N.W. laying under 2 try sails and bobbed fore stay sail
one sail in sight

Tuesday Oct 11th

This 24 hours blowing a gale from W.N.W. laying under storm sails on the Southern tack

Wednesday Oct 12th

First part of this 24 hours strong breeze from S.W. heading on the Northern tack under fore sail and reef mainsail last part blowing heavy from S.W. with rain steering W by N $\frac{1}{2}$ N under close reef fore and main sails and fore stay sail

Long 53.37 W.

Thursday Oct 13th

Begins with a heavy gale from S.W. heading on the Western tack under close reef fore and main sails middle part more moderate under single reef sails last part wind N.W. under fore and main sails one steamer and several fishermen in sight spoke Scho Dawson City of Boston
