

Thursday Oct 20th

The first part of this 24 hours
thick fog and rain and a strong
breeze from S.E. laying on different
tacks under reefed fore sail
and main try sail at 7 A.M.
wind hauled to the S.W. headed
on the Northern tack at 9 A.M.
raised the land close to Chatham
wind hauled to the Northward
headed to the Westward under
all sail for Vineyard Sound
at 3 P.M. passed Cross Rip Light
Boat at 4 P.M. took a Pilot off
of Cotage City in Steamer Lucie B.
and she took us in tow at 6 P.M.
calm at 6.30 P.M. entered Quicks
Hole at 7 got through and shaped
our course for New Bedford came to
an anchor at 9.30 P.M. in the Harbor
in 3 fathoms of water
