

Ship Franklin in the South Atlantic

5th This day commences with a gale from the S. E. Ship on the Starboard tack under double reefed topsails Fore Sail Main Spencer and Fore Mast Stay Sail

6th This morning is calm a breeze sprang up at ten o'clock A.M. from the S. E. Ship steering S. W. by W.

7th This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. E. by E.

8th This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack Raised a Pin back

9th This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. W. by S. Raised Pin backs this afternoon

10th This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. E. by E. Saw a Pin back this afternoon

11th This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. E. by E. Spoke the Ship George Washington of Wareham Raised Pin backs

12th This day commences with a moderate breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. W. by W. Spoke the Ship Abraham Barker of New Bedford Saw Pin backs

13th This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. E. by E. Spoke the Ship George Washington of Wareham Fore Sail in sight Raised Whales to night

14th A breeze sprang up at three o'clock P.M. having been calm all day Ship steering S. E. Fore Sail in sight

15th This day commences with light winds Ship steering S. W. Fore sail in sight Spoke the Ship Geo Brown and Bark Louisa of New Bedford

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16th This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. W. by W. Spoke the Ship Raindeer of New Bedford Raised Pin backs at Goddard's

17th This day commences with fine weather Ship steering S. W. Fore Sail in sight Raised Pin backs

18th A breeze sprang up having been calm all the morning Ship steering by the wind Signalized the Ship George of New Bedford Spoke the Bark Edward

19th This day commences with light winds from the S. W. Ship steering S. E. by E. Fore Sail in sight standing along on the Starboard tack

20th This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. E. by E. Spoke the Br Ship Star at Goddard's from Cardenas bound to Callao

21st This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. E. by E.

22nd Wind S. E. Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack fine weather with a light breeze

23rd This day commences with fine weather Wind S. E. Ship steering S. W. by W. Fore Sail in sight ahead steering S. W.

24th This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. W. Ship steering S. W. by W. The wind increased to a gale Fore sail in sight

25th This morning the gale has lulled a little The wind continues to S. W. Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack

26th Raised the Land at three one-half o'clock P.M. Four points on the Lea Bar being the Falkland Islands one Sail in sight the weather is equally Wind S. W. Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack
