

Ship Franklin in the South Atlantic

27th This day commences with a light breeze from the N.W. Ship steering S. One Sail in sight steering to the Southward

28th This day commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. Ship steering S. & E. Raised the Land at half past four P.M.

29th This day commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. Ship steering S. G. C. Spike. Met some of the Bedford The Island of Staten Land and Seven Sail in sight

30th This day commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. Ship steering S. G. W. Saw a Ship homeward bound of the Land and nine sail are in sight

31st This day commences with fine weather Wind N.W. Ship steering S. off the Island of Terra Del Fuego and five Sail in sight

Jan^y 1st 1854 This day commences with fine weather Wind N.W. Ship steering S. off the Land and six sail are in sight Saw a Spout this afternoon on the Starboard Beam

2^d This day commences with squally weather Wind N.W. Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack Three Sail in sight Raised a Fire back this afternoon on the Starboard Beam

3^d This day commences with a light breeze from N.W. Ship steering N.W. Six sail in sight Saw the Ship Eagle of New York

4th This day commences with Rainy weather Wind N.W. Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack Four Sail in sight

5th This day commences with squally weather Wind S.E. Ship steering N.W. One Sail in sight

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6th This day commences with squally weather Wind S. Ship steering N.W. One Sail in sight steering to the Westward

7th This day commences with squally weather Wind S.W. Ship steering N.W. Three Sail in sight Saw a Ship steering to the Eastward

8th This day commences with squally weather Wind S. off Ship steering N.W. One Sail in sight Saw the Ship of Abornok of Galenouth

9th This day commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. Ship steering S. off the Land One Sail in sight Saw a Spout to night

10th This day commences with a gale from the S. Ship steering N.W. Nothing in sight

11th This day commences with a light breeze from the S. Ship steering N.W. Raised the Land

12th This day commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. Ship steering N.W. One Sail in sight

13th This day commences with foggy weather Wind S. Ship steering N.W. Raised all the masts run off for them. Made them out Firebacks

14th This day commences with a moderate breeze from the S. Ship steering N.W. Spoke the Ship of Abornok of Galenouth Raised Firebacks

15th This day commences with fine weather Wind S. Ship steering N.W. One Sail in sight

16th This day commences with fine weather Raised the Land at day light then down along the Land until 9 o'clock then then sailed the Main Topsail to the Mast toward the Starboard Boat and went ahead in company with four of the Galenouth's Boats. Came aboard at six o'clock P.M. with a load of Potatoes
