

3^d This day commences with a strong breeze from the N^W Ship steering close hauled on the Port tack Middle light winds Latter part the same I hope the Ship Gideon offnd and gamed with her

4th This day commences with light Winds At 7 o'clock P^m set the collar for a Boat to come from the Gideon after the Capt. Raised off whales at 6 o'clock Am did not lower for them Lat 52° 10' Long 164° 40'

5th This day commences with a light breeze from the N^W Ship by the wind Land with the Ship Gideon offnd Raised a Right Whale at 6 o'clock Am Toward 3 Boats and chased it but were unsuccessful The Boats came along side at 7 o'clock Am and were hoisted & raced forward the main yard and stood along on the Port tack

6th This day commences with light winds from the N^W Ship steering close hauled on the Port tack one Sail in sight Middle steering N^W Latter part the same 5 Sail in sight Saw a spout at 6 o'clock Am Lat 53° 30' Long 163° 10'

7th This day commences with light winds from the N^W Raised the Ice at 1 o'clock P^m Run for it and came up to it at 3 o'clock P^m Raised Whales in around the Ice made them out Bow heads Toward the Boats and chased them When one had got up with them they proved to be Gulf harbottle ms The Boats came along side hoisted the Boats braced Toward the main yard and stood along in the Port tack until 6 o'clock Am then luffed Ship Raised the Land at 8 1/2 o'clock Am Middle strong breeze Latter part the same Lat 53° 51' Long 160° 50'

8th This day commences with a strong breeze from the N^W and Tacked Ship at 1 o'clock P^m and

stood away from the Land 1 Sail in sight Saw a spout at 3 o'clock P^m Lat 53° 51' Long 163° 21'

9th This day commences with a strong breeze from the N^W Tacked Ship at 12 1/2 o'clock P^m and stood on the Starboard tack 1 Sail in sight Middle the same Latter part moderate wind

10th This day commences with a light breeze from the N^W Raised off whales at 10 o'clock P^m Toward the Boats and chased them but proving to be Humpbacks gave up the chase Toward the Bow Boat a 3 o'clock P^m and chased Humpbacks to try the Bomb Lance got on to one and shot a Lance but missed the whale Middle strong Winds Latter part the same with Snow squalls The Land and 2 Sail in sight

11th This day commences with a strong breeze from the N^W Ship steering close hauled on the Port tack doubled reefed on the Fore and Main topsail Hurlid the Mizzen topsail 1st Main Sail and 1st miter Raised Bhering's Island at 4 o'clock Am

12th This day commences with a strong breeze from the N^W Ship steering close hauled on the Port tack Raised a spout at 2 o'clock P^m prove to be Humpbacks Bhering's Island and 2 Sail are in sight Middle Moderate winds Latter part the same Raised a spout at 7 o'clock Am

13th This day commences with the wind from the N^W Ship steering close hauled on the Port tack Middle light winds Latter part off wind & N^W Raised a spout at 5 o'clock Am it proved to be a Right Whale N^W and half Toward the Boats and chased them
