

9th Commences with a strong breeze from the N.E. Ship standing along on the Starboard Tack Raised Whales at 3 o'clock Am Three Sail in sight

10th Commences with a light breeze from the N Ship steering by the Wind 9 Sail in sight Raised the Land at 5 o'clock Am

11th Commences with a light breeze from the S Ship steering N.E. Middle strong Winds Latter part the same Spoke the Ship Majestic of New Bedford at 11 o'clock Pm Run across the Stern of the Ship William Patch The Land and 11 Sail are in sight Spoke the Ship Nigar of New Bedford at 1 o'clock Am Lat 65° 34' Long 179° 34'

12th Commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. Ship steering W.S.W. Spoke the Ship Eliza of Mason and gained with her The Land and 22 Sail are in sight

13th Commences with a light breeze from the N.E. Ship steering S.E. Gained with the Ship Eliza of Mason The Land and 7 Sail are in sight

14th Commences with a strong breeze Ship steering S.E. Spoke the Ship Brooklyn of New London at 4 o'clock Pm and gained with her The Land and 19 Sail are in sight

15th Commences with a light breeze Ship steering S.S.W. Johnny man a Kanaka a native of Maui died at 2 o'clock Pm after an illness of a month At 4 o'clock the Deck's were cleared up The corpse was brought up and laid out on a board and sewed up in a piece of bonvass with a bag of Brick and Sand lashed to it to sink it ready for Burial The Main Top sail was laid to the Mast the Men called down from the Mast head mustered all hands into the Wast The Capt the commenced the funeral service by reading a chapter in the Bible

and a Prayer for a token of respect for our deared Shipmate The Body was then committed to the deep Squared the yards and kept the Ship her course Saw a spout at 3 o'clock Pm Lat 61° 40'

16th Commences with a light breeze Ship steering S.S.E. Gained with the Ship Christopher Mitchel and P. Larois at 2 o'clock Pm Halled aback the Main yard at 5 o'clock and lay until 5 1/2 o'clock Am 13 Sail in sight

17th Commences with a light breeze Ship steering close halled on the wind Saw a spout at 2 1/2 o'clock Pm Gained with the Ship Lewis Raised a spout at 9 o'clock Am Spoke the Bark Valparaiso of New Bedford at 10 1/2 o'clock Am The Land and 15 Sail in sight

18th Commences with a light breeze Ship steering S.S.W. Gained with the Ship Lewis William Patch and Bark Valparaiso The Land and 7 Sail are in sight

19th Commences with a strong breeze Ship steering N.W. 1/2 W. Saw a spout at 6 o'clock Pm Spoke the Bark Canton Packet of New Bedford at 8 1/2 o'clock The Land and 9 Sail are in sight

20th Commences with a strong breeze Ship steering close halled on the wind Gained with the Bark Canton Packet 2 Sail in sight Tacked Ship at 2 o'clock Am and stood to the South ward

21st Commences with a strong breeze Ship steering to the S Tacked Ship at 6 o'clock Pm and stood to the N having Raised Ice ahead 2 Sail in sight

22^d Commences with a strong breeze Raised Ice at 5 o'clock Pm Middle Foggy Latter part the same Raised Whales at 5 1/2 o'clock Am 8 Sail in sight Ship steering S.E.
