

- Windlas and hove it up Made Sail and Middle stormy latter part the same
- 5th Commences with Foggy weather Middle the same Raised the Land at 2 o'clock Am latter part clear Ship steering N^W E Raised Whales toward the boats and chased them but were unsuccessful The Natives came aboard at 11 o'clock to trade for Tobacco Lat 64° 33'
- 6th Commences with a strong breeze Middle Foggy latter part clear Ship steering N^W E Raised the Land at 5 o'clock Am
- 7th Commences with a strong breeze Ship running through Bhering Straits to the Northward diggers Middle Foggy latter part the same Raised offussle
- 8th Commences with Foggy weather Ship under double reefed Main Topsail and Fore Topsail stay sail Middle strong breeze latter part the same Made Sail at 5 o'clock Am Lat 67° 22' Long 170° 09'
- 9th Commences with a strong breeze Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack Tacked Ship at 1 o'clock Am and kept N^W by N Raised Mussle diggers Lat 67° 24'
- 10th Commences with a moderate breeze Raised Point Hope at 5 o'clock pm Middle strong W^{ind}s latter part the same Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack
- 11th Commences with a strong breeze from the S toward the Bow and Waist Boat and pulled into the Ice after Walruses The Bow Boat got fast to Ice but lost them The Waist Boat got fast to one and succeeded in pulling it toward the Ship and hoisted it on deck and skinned it and threw the carcass overboard all excepting the Liver which we ate Raised Mussle diggers Ship standing along on the Starboard tack
- 12th Commences with a light breeze Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack Raised Mussle diggers
- 13th Commences with light winds Ship steering S. P. E. Raised the Land at 11 o'clock Am
- 14th Commences with light winds Ship steering S The Land is in sight
- 15th Commences with a light breeze Ship running through Bhering Straits to the S The Natives came aboard from the Dyomedes with Walrus tusks to trade but wanted Run for them Raised a sail at 5 o'clock pm Spoke the Bark James Andrews of New Bedford at 11 o'clock pm Raised a sail at 10 1/2 o'clock Am Saw Mussle diggers Lat 64° 55' Long 169° 30'
- 16th Commences with a moderate breeze Spoke the Ship Charles Carroll of San Francisco at 3 o'clock pm and guarded with her and the Bark James Andrews Middle Foggy latter part clear Ship steering S by W The Land and 6 sail are in sight
- 17th Commences with a strong breeze Spoke the Ship William Thompson of New Bedford at 4 o'clock pm Middle Rainy latter part Foggy Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack The Land and 6 sail are in sight
- 18th Commences with Foggy weather Raised the Land at 12 o'clock noon Spoke the Ship George of New Bedford at 12 1/2 o'clock pm
- 19th Commences with foggy weather Ship running along the Land to the Westward Land with the Ship Cutissoft of New Bedford The Natives came aboard at 11 o'clock Am The Land and 8 sail are in sight
- 20th Commences with a light breeze Spoke the Ship Pouscan at 5 o'clock pm and guarded with her Ship laying to with the main topsail to the mast Braced forward and kept the Ship N^W by N Raised Mussle diggers
