

21st Commences with light winds Land with Ship Rousseau at 4 o'clock P.M. Saw a Bowhead did not lower for it The Land and 7 Sail are in sight

22^d Commences with light winds Spoke the Ship Illinois at 4 o'clock P.M. and gamed with her Saw a Bowhead but did not lower for it Ship steering E N E The Land and 7 Sail are in sight

23^d Commences with a strong breeze Raised the Land at 1 o'clock P.M. Ship steering close hauled on the port tack 5 Sail in sight Lat 65 30

24th Commences with a moderate breeze Ship steering N N W 10 sail in sight

25th Commences with a strong breeze from the S W Ship steering close hauled on the port tack 5 Sail in sight

26th Commences with light winds Ship lying to with the Main Top Sail to the Mast Braced forward at 4 1/2 o'clock P.M. and stood on the port tack Raised a Bowhead 10 o'clock P.M. not seeing it again did not lower the Boats & Sail are in sight

27th Commences with a strong breeze from the S W Spoke the Bark Harvest of New Bedford at 5 o'clock P.M. Raised the Land at 3 o'clock P.M. Ship steering close hauled on the starboard tack 2 Sail are in sight

28th Commences with a strong breeze Raised the Land at 3 o'clock P.M. Gamed with the Ship Abraham Barker and Bark Harvest at 5 P.M. Spoke the Ship Nigar at 6 o'clock A.M. and gamed with her the Abraham Barker and Harvest

29th Commences with a strong breeze Ship under double reef Top Sails steering N E Middle the same latter part light winds The Land and 4 Sail are in sight

30th Commences with a light breeze Ship steering S W & Middle foggy latter part strong breeze 4 Sail are in sight

31st Commences with a light breeze Ship steering S E & Spoke the Ship Vice yard of Edgartown at 7 o'clock P.M. and gamed with her Middle strong winds latter part the same The Land and 4 Sail are in sight

Aug the 1st 1854 Commences with a strong breeze Ship steering S W Whilst the Starboard Watch were up on the main yard a pulling the main sail a man fell from the yard on deck and broke one of his arms and badly injuring his head He was taken up senseless and carried down into the cabin and brought to Raised the Land at 3 o'clock P.M. Raised Bowheads at 4 1/2 o'clock A.M. Lowered the Boats and chased them but were unsuccessful The Land and 7 Sail are in sight

2^d Commences with light winds Raised Bowheads at 12 o'clock Night Lowered the Boats and chased them but were unsuccessful Raised Bowheads at 6 o'clock A.M. but did not lower for them Ship steering close hauled on the wind The Land and 6 Sail are in sight Spoke the Ship George at 9 o'clock P.M.

3^d Commences with a strong breeze from the S Ship steering N N W Spoke the Ship John of New Bedford at 6 o'clock P.M. and gamed with her The Land and 1 Sail are in sight

4th Commences with a strong breeze from the S Gamed with the Ship John at 4 o'clock P.M. Ship steering close hauled on the starboard tack Raised Muzzle Liggers 3 Sail are in sight

5th Commences with a strong breeze from the N W Ship steering S E & Raised the Land at 5 o'clock P.M. Gamed with the Ship John at 7 o'clock P.M. 2 Sail are in sight

6th Commences with light winds from the S E Raised a Bowhead at 2 1/2 o'clock P.M. Lowered the Boats and chased it but were unsuccessful came along side at 3 1/2 o'clock P.M. and hauled the Boats Ship steering N W 2 Sail are in sight
