

7th Commences with a strong breeze raised
to sail at 8 o'clock. On raised the land
at 3 o'clock. A M Ship standing
along close hauled on the starboard tack
wore around at 4. A M stood S E
8th Commences with a strong breeze
from the East Ship steering close
hauled on the port tack middle and
latter part the same saw two ship
in sight

9th Commences with a strong breeze middle
and latter part foggy steering close
hauled on the port tack

10th Commences with a strong breeze from the W
Raised a sail at 6 o'clock. On spoke the ship
Gideon Howland at 7 o'clock. M middle
foggy latter part the same hauled with the
Gideon Howland at 9 o'clock. A M ship
steering close hauled on the port tack

11th Commences with foggy weather wind W N W
middle light winds latter part the same
3 sail are in sight

12th Commences with light winds hauled with
the ships Gideon Howland Fenn and Bark
James Andrews ship steering by the wind
5 sail are in sight

13th Commences with light winds hauled with the
ships Gideon Howland Rousseau and Bark
James Andrews at 6 o'clock. M middle strong
breeze latter part the same ship steering close
hauled on the starboard tack

14th Commences with a strong breeze from N E
Ship steering close hauled on the starboard
tack hauled with the ships Gideon Howland

William Thompson Rousseau and Bark
James Andrews 5 sail in sight Lat 64 22 Long 171 45

15th Commences with a strong breeze from N E
Ship steering close hauled on the port tack
Raised ice at 2 o'clock. M 4 sail are in sight

16th Commences with a light breeze from the
E Raised a Bonhead at 1 1/2 o'clock. On lower
2 boats and chased it but were unsuccessful
Ship steering close hauled on the starboard
tack 4 sail are in sight

17th Commences with light winds Raised
Hampback's ship steering close hauled
on the starboard tack hauled with the ships
William Thompson and Gideon Howland
4 sail are in sight

18th Commences with light winds from the
N E Ship steering close hauled on the
starboard tack hauled with the ship
William Thompson at 6 o'clock. M Raised
the land at 2 1/2 o'clock. A M

19th Commences with a light breeze from the
N Ship steering close hauled on the port
tack middle the same latter part foggy
The land and 3 sail are in sight

20th Commences with foggy weather Wind E
Ship steering close hauled on the starboard
tack. Hauled with the ship William Thompson
and Gideon Howland Raised Bonheads
8 o'clock. A M lowered the boats and chased
them but were unsuccessful

21st Commences with a moderate breeze lowered
the boats at 12 o'clock and chased Bonheads
The starboard boat got fast and held on
until the Iron brake came along side at 3 o'clock
P M and hoisted the boats The land and
two sail are in sight
