

25th commences with a strong breeze from the N^W Ship steering close hauled on the wind at 6 o'clock AM I spoke the Bark Rebecca Adams at 12 o'clock PM The Land and 2 Sail are in sight Lat 18° 41' Long 105° 35'

26th commences with a strong breeze from the N^W Gamed with the Bark Rebecca Adams of San Francisco at 5 o'clock PM Ship steering close hauled Middle and Latter part moderate winds The Land and 2 Sail are in sight Lat 19° 09'

27th commences with a moderate breeze from the S^E Ship steering close hauled on the wind Saw a spout at 3 o'clock PM could not make out what it was Raised a shoal of 4 sperm Whales at 8 o'clock AM Lowered the Boats and chased them The Bow Boat got on and fastened The Starboard Boat fast next and succeeded in turning it up hauled along side at 12 o'clock noon and hoisted the Boats

28th commences with light winds from the N^W Ship steering close hauled commenced cutting in at 1 o'clock PM Men employed in clearing up decks and starting the try works The Land and 2 Sail in sight Lat 18° 44'

29th commences with a moderate breeze from N^W Ship steering close hauled on the wind Raised Whales at 2 o'clock PM Lowered the Boats and chased the the starboard Boat got fast to a ball and succeeded in turning it up hauled it along side and hoisted it in Raised Whales at 6 o'clock AM Lowered the Boats and chased them the starboard Boat got fast to one and succeeded in turning it up hauled it along side at 10 o'clock AM Lat 18° 51'

30th commences with light winds from the N^W Ship The Boats came along side at 12 o'clock PM having given up the chase Raised Whales again at 2 o'clock Lowered the Boats and chased them The Starboard Boat got on to on the Boatsteerer darted the bow but missed him came along side at 5 o'clock PM and hoisted up the Boats Men employed in cutting in and trying out Lat 18° 25' Long 105° 51'

Dec the 1st 1854 commences with light winds from the S^E Gamed with the Bark Rebecca Adams at 4 o'clock PM Lowered the Starboard Boat and chased Sulphur bottom the Capt shot a Bomb Lard and to one Ship steering close hauled on the wind The Land and 1 Sail are in sight Lat 18° 44' Long 105° 35'

2^d commences with a light breeze from N^W Ship steering close hauled on the wind Middle the same Latter part strong winds Men employed in breaking out The Land and 1 Sail in sight Lat 19° 15'

3^d commences with a strong breeze from the N^W Raised a Sail at 2 o'clock PM Steering close hauled a Steamer at 6 o'clock AM Standing to the S^E did not make out her name Men employed in breaking out Ship steering close hauled on the wind The Land and 3 Sail are in sight Lat 19° 21'

4th commences with moderate winds from the N^W Middle strong breezes Latter part the same Ship steering close hauled on the wind Raised Whales hauled back for them but not seeing them again did not lower the Boats for them 2 Sail are in sight Lat 19° 14'

5th commences with light winds from the N^W I spoke the Bark Rebecca Adams at 9 o'clock PM Ship steering close hauled on the wind The Land and 1 Sail are in sight Lat 19° 25'

6th commences with light winds from the N^W Middle and Latter part strong breezes Ship steering close hauled Raised 4 umpacks at 7 o'clock AM Men employed in working in the rigging The Land and 1 Sail are in sight Lat 19° 25'

7th commences with a strong breeze from the N^W Raised Whales at 6 o'clock PM Ship steering close
