

Ship Franklin in the Port of Lahaina

and its crew were able to go in the ship. They
might go but none were able to go in the
ship when it was ready for sea I was
discharged the 20th of Feb I got able to go
to work in about 4 months and went to
work to Hakuwao situated on East Maui
and worked a farming about 3 or 4 months
and then came back to Lahaina and stayed
to the hospital until Fall the town of Lahaina
is situated on West Maui the houses are
built of wood and thatched with a
kind of plant & there has been
several deaths since I have been
in the Hospital.

Oct the 22^d 1855 Today I shipped aboard the
Ship Rambler of Nantucket Capt Winch
Commander now laying in the harbour at
Lahaina bound to the 10th of

27th came aboard at 10 o'clock from the ship being
ready for sea after being on the Island of
Maui about 5 months

28th commences with fine weather weighed anchor
and got under weigh with a light breeze from
the S.E. and kept the ship off to the S. for Oahu
Raised the land at daylight and stood in
towards it

29th commences with a light breeze from S.E.
Ship laying off and on to Oahu toward
away a boat and pulled ashore to get a new
pump one of them having given out

30th commences with a strong breeze ship
laying off and on to Oahu the boat
came along side at 4 o'clock with the
new pump hoisted it in on deck braced
forward and stood abt shore toward the
boat at 7 o'clock A.M. and went ashore
after the carpenter to ship the new
pump the boat came along side at 11
o'clock A.M. with the carpenter

31st commences with a strong breeze from
the S.E. ship laying off and on toward
a boat and went ashore after the
capt and came up at 4 o'clock the
steward did not come aboard in
the boat the mate ordered the boat
to maned and went ashore after him
the boat came along side at 11 o'clock
hoisted it more round and stood to
the southward and westward

Nov the 1st 1855 commences with a strong
breeze from the S.E. ship steering
close hauled on the port tack there
is not much to do except to trim
sails and pump ship.
