

we then went up as far as Ula
 where I stayed until the man
 that I went with went to Ghorne
 and stayed all night after he came
 back we got underway and and
 started back again (There is a
 legend of the natives concerning this
 bay they say a great while ago that
 a great fish much larger than
 a whale came into the bay and
 tried to divide the Island but after
 trying for a long time he gave
 it up and turned round but it
 would not go out the same place
 that it came in at so he took a
 rather course to go out to sea but
 after getting most out it died
 and turned into an Island) We
 came back as far as Varnap where we
 stayed all night we got underway
 the next morning and came around
 this side of the Island and got
 up as far as Malare where we waited
 until the tide began to rise

31st Commences with fair weather & this
 morning we got underway and
 came up to Mafafhalie There has
 been a considerable going on since
 I have been away the House and
 Consulate of St. Vincent has been
 advertised for sale and will be sold
 at auction tomorrow The Louisiana is
 in port and the Albatross came in to
 day and we have layed off and
 on the name of which I do not
 recollect and four schooners
 some of them having arrived since
 I have been away one being ordered
 by Sydney the other a Bahian schooner
 I have not learned her name yet

From 1st to 16th Commences with fair
 weather I have been aboard of
 the Schooner Eudorus to work to
 help break out the oil but did
 not break it out on account of the
 Lt Marshal coming aboard he having
 intended to sell it at auction with
 the rest of the Sail Vancamp property
 the rest of the things being sold
 first The Marshal having employed
 me to go aboard of the Schooner
 I have not learned the particulars
 of the sale & there has been a protest
 made against the sale by C. V. Phelps

2nd Commences with fair weather
 I have been aboard the Schooner
 Eudorus to work helping break
 out the Auction came off on
 board to day in which the oil
 anchors cables &c belonging to
 the Rambler and St. Marys

3rd Commences with fair weather
 I have not been to work to day
 I have shifted my boarding
 house until the Council can
 get settled The Bark Alabama
 of Gen Bedford arrived in
 port to day

4th Commences with fair weather There
 is nothing worth noting to day The
 Bark Alabama that arrived in port
 yesterday belongs to Gen Bedford
 instead of Gen Bedford

5th Commences with fair weather I
 have been to Matabutan this
 afternoon There is nothing worth
 noting happened to day

6th Commences with fair weather I
 have not been doing any thing to
 day The Ship Lion of Providence
 has been laying off and on all
 day
