 6<sup>th</sup> Commences with fair weather I have  
 not been doing much except making  
 out my bill against A. Vancouver  
 7<sup>th</sup> Commences with fair weather I went  
 aboard the Ship Louisiana this morning  
 with a shipmate of mine that had shipped  
 aboard of her & there has been an auction  
 here this afternoon in which the resin  
 stock of Aaron Vancouver was sold there  
 was a row this afternoon between the  
 U.S. Marshal and the Consul  
 8<sup>th</sup> Commences with fair weather I went  
 to the Consul this morning I have  
 made out to settle up with V.P.  
 & Chapin this afternoon  
 9<sup>th</sup> Commences with fair weather I have  
 been over to Matanta to help pull a  
 boat that was sold at auction last Wednesday  
 there nothing worth noting occurred to day  
 10<sup>th</sup> Commences with fair weather The  
 American Consul came to me  
 this morning and wanted me to ship  
 aboard of the Ship Louisiana Capt  
 Norton master but I declined to  
 ship before the mast he told me  
 that I must ship or pay my board  
 for the government could not support  
 me much longer aboard to day the  
 American schooner and apt schooner Santh  
 Seedes Ship Louisiana Norton and  
 the Schooner Eudorus Semen I went  
 aboard of the Eudorus and stayed  
 untill she was outside of the reef  
 and came back with Baker the Pilot

11<sup>th</sup> Commences with changeable weather  
 Sunday is a dull day in general but  
 to day is duller than common I have  
 not been doing any thing to day  
 12<sup>th</sup> Commences with fair weather I went  
 to Matanta this forenoon there was  
 a meeting of the foreign residents at  
 10 o'clock Am at the Free Chapel to see  
 about subscription a vote for the  
 children of foreigners & the U.S. Church  
 has resigned his office in account of  
 the difficulty that he had with  
 the U.S. Consul aboard the Ship  
 Minerva of New Bedford cruise  
 13<sup>th</sup> Commences with fair weather I went  
 over to Matanta this forenoon the Ship  
 Isaac Howland chartered of New Bedford  
 have been laying off and on all day there  
 is nothing more worthy of note has happened  
 14<sup>th</sup> Commences with changeable weather  
 I have been down to the Consul to  
 see about shipping the Ship Isaac  
 Howland and Minerva are still  
 laying off and on the Emily effort  
 arrived in port to day  
 15<sup>th</sup> Commences with cloudy weather I have  
 not been doing anything to day except  
 cruising about the Ship Isaac Howland  
 and Minerva are laying off and on the  
 American Consul has put up a notice  
 nominating R.L. Turner U.S. Marshal  
 16<sup>th</sup> Commences with fair weather I have  
 not been doing anything to day the  
 Ship Isaac Howland Minerva are lying  
 off and on there is nothing going on to day  
 17<sup>th</sup> Commences with fair weather I heard  
 the American Ship Alabama Capt in Master  
 the British schooner of England to trade  
 around the Islands the Ship Fox Brothers  
 is lying off and on the Consul mentioned
