

- Helm squared the yards and kept the ship S W Men employed in sending down the Mainsail sending in the Gib and hoisting another Gib and Mainsail.
- 16th Commences with a fresh breeze from the Eastward Ship steering S W Raised Parouses this afternoon Braced up the yards and pulled on the Starboard tack Men employed in sending down the Main Top Gallant Sloop and overhauling the rigging on the yard.
- 17th Commences with fair weather Wind from the Eastward Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack Men employed in sending up the Main Top Gallant yard crossing it across the fore stay and setting it up Raised Parouses.
- 18th Commences with a light breeze from the Eastward Ship steering close hauled on the port tack squared the yards at 8 o'clock and kept the ship S W Men employed in making a foreyard &c.
- 19th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S W Ship steering S W Shortened sail at sunset braced up the yards and pulled on the Starboard tack kept the ship S W at 4 o'clock Men employed in working on the rigging and making a foreyard.
- 20th Commences with a fresh breeze from the Eastward Ship steering S W pulled on the port tack at 6 o'clock squared the yards at 8 o'clock and kept the ship S W Raised of our distant Island at 10 o'clock Men at 11 o'clock braced up the yards at 12 o'clock and hauled on the port tack.

- 21st Commences with a fresh breeze from the Eastward squared the yards after dinner and ran for the land until 1 o'clock pm we then layed the Foretopsail to the mast down two boats and pulled ashore. This Island is uninhabited the only vegetable that grows on this Island there is a ~~few~~ ^{small} ~~occasionally~~ ^{here} where ship leave letters occasionally there is a numerous quantity of Birds here the only thing that we got was some Birds Eggs we intended to have stayed and fished a spell but it coming on a strong breeze we came aboard about 5 o'clock braced up the yards and stood along on the port tack Men employed in setting up the fore rigging.
- 22^d Commences with a fresh breeze from the S W Ship steering close hauled on the port tack shortened sail at sunset hauled in at 10 o'clock more ship and stood along on the Starboard tack Men employed in working on the rigging.
- 23^d Commences with a moderate breeze from the S W Ship steering close hauled on the Starboard tack Men employed in setting up the Main rigging I saw the brightest meteor that I ever witnessed it being light enough to see to pick a pin up off deck.
- 24th Commences with light winds from the S W Ship steering close hauled on the port tack Men employed in setting up the Main rigging.
- 25th Commences with light winds from the S W Ship steering close hauled on the port tack kept the ship at anchor and stood along on the Starboard tack Men employed in working on the rigging and making a foreyard.
