

6th Commences with calm weather there is a
hark to the windward then employe
in working on the rigging and making spungoon
7th Commences with a light breeze from the
Eastward and with the Barks Anaschank
5th Sail of Ship in sight spoke the Ship
Patawack of Nantucket at 8 o'clock Am
then employe in performing ships duty
8th Commences with light winds from the E
Ship steering close hauled on the starboard
tack there ship at 10 o'clock Am and stood
along on the port tack and with the
Patawack at 4 o'clock Pm 8 sail in sight
then employe in doing ships duty
9th Commences with a fresh breeze from
the N E Ship steering close hauled on
the port tack the Capt went aboard
the Patawack at 10 o'clock Pm then employe
in breaking out for water & sail in sight
10th Commences with a fresh breeze from the
E Ship steering close hauled on the starboard
tack raised the Barks at 10 o'clock Pm toward
the Boat and then the Barks got
fast and proceeded in turning it up the
Barks got fast but the Barks drew off he
Barks got fast and proceeded in turning
them up the Barks along side and let
them lay all night Commences cutting in
at 6 o'clock Am and finished cutting at
10 o'clock Am with a moderate breeze
11th Commences with a moderate breeze
from the Eastward and the ship at
1 o'clock Pm and stood along on the
port tack started the tryworks at
2 o'clock Am raised a sail at 2 o'clock
12th Commences with a moderate breeze from
the Eastward raised a sail to the windward
at 1 o'clock Pm spoke the Barks at 6 o'clock
of Dartmouth at 8 o'clock Pm then employe
in finishing trying out and clearing up
Doctors one sail in sight Ship steering
close hauled on the starboard tack

13th Commences with a moderate breeze from
the Eastward raised the Barks at 4 o'clock
Pm on the weather beam about 2 miles
off toward the Boat and chased them
the Barks got fast rounded out
about half the line and hauled from
the Barks the came along side at 6 o'clock
Pm and were hoisted up braced forward
the mainyard and the Barks on the
port tack one sail in sight then employe
in cropping oil
14th Commences with a moderate breeze from
the Eastward Ship steering close hauled on
the starboard tack spoke the Barks at 10 o'clock
at 10 o'clock Pm then employe in cropping oil
15th Commences with a fresh breeze from the
East Ship steering close hauled on the starboard
tack then employe in cropping and
standing down oil the Barks at 6 o'clock
Am and stood along on the port tack
16th Commences with a fresh breeze from
the Eastward there ship at 6 o'clock Pm
and stood on the starboard tack there
Ship at 7 o'clock Am and stood along on
the port tack then employe in standing
down oil
17th Commences with a moderate breeze
from the N E Ship steering close
hauled on the port tack the Barks
in sight at daylight on the starboard
quarter raised Byrnes Island at
4 o'clock Am hearing 6th distant about
4 leagues soon after raised Peru Island
18th Commences with a moderate breeze from
the Eastward the Barks came off from Byrnes
Island to trade hats and mats for
Tobacco this afternoon the Barks of
this Island go entirely naked except
the women who have covering made
at 4 o'clock Am the Barks that reaches from
their Barks at 10 o'clock Am and stood along on the
port tack
