

- 4th Commences with light winds from the East
Sailed round the yards at 5th o'clock P.m.
and stood along on the port tack then employ
in working on the rigging
- 5th Commences with a fresh breeze from the East
Ship steering close hauled on the port tack
Raised Pleasant Island bearing S by E leagues
distant at 9 o'clock kept the ship off and
stood for it then employed in being ships duty
- 6th Commences with a moderate breeze from the
Eastward The natives came aboard at 8 o'clock
P.m. to trade for tobacco The boats at the
natives are the same as on the other Islands
of the Islands hills groups of trees toward
the north and stood on the starboard tack
The Bow Boat went ashore to trade for
squashes and bread Raised the land this
morning bearing E about 2 miles distant
Wore ship at 2 o'clock and stood on the
port tack then employed in breaking out for water
- 7th Commences with a moderate breeze from
the Eastward Raised beaches at 8 o'clock P.m.
ahead made them act as wind sails but
they were going to the windward we
did not lower the boats for them Wore
Ship at 2 o'clock and stood on the starboard
tack
- 8th Commences with a moderate breeze
from the E. S. E. Ship steering close hauled
on the starboard tack then employed
in working on the rigging
- 9th Commences with a light breeze from the
Eastward Ship steering close hauled on the
starboard tack then employed in breaking
out for pipe shanks to make a skuttle
Bottle ranch working on the rigging
- 10th Commences with a light breeze from
the Eastward Ship steering close hauled on the
starboard tack then employed in working
on the rigging and painting ship.

- 12th Commences with light winds from the Eastward
Wore ship at 6 o'clock P.m. and stood along on the
port tack then employed in doing ship's duty
- 13th Commences with light winds from the Eastward
Ship steering close hauled on the port tack Raised
2 sail at 6 o'clock and spoke the ship Elizabeth
of Sen Bedford Capt Mince and gained with
her and the Othello of Sen Bedford at 8 o'clock
Am then employed in working on the rigging
and breaking out for water
- 14th Commences with a moderate breeze from
the Eastward Ship steering close hauled on
the port tack hauled back the mainyard
at 6 o'clock the Elizabeth was close to us
and gained with us then employed in working on
the rigging and painting ship
- 15th Commences with a fresh breeze from the
Eastward Ship steering close hauled on the
port tack hauled a foreback at 6 o'clock and
Wore ship at 8 o'clock and
- 16th Commences with a gently weather Wind
from the Eastward Ship steering close hauled
on the starboard tack then employed in
preparing ship's duty
- 17th Commences with a fresh breeze from
the Eastward Ship steering close hauled on
the starboard tack Raised a sail at 6 o'clock
Wore land with the ship from the north of
Sen Bedford at 6 o'clock then Wore ship
at 7 o'clock and stood along on the port
tack then employed in setting up shooks for water
- 18th Commences with a strong breeze from the
Eastward Ship steering close hauled on the port
tack hauled back the foretopmast and layed
all night broad board the foreyard at day
light then employed in setting up shooks and
painting ship
- 19th Commences with a fresh breeze from the
Eastward Ship steering close hauled on the
port tack Raised Pleasant Island at 6
o'clock bearing S by E leagues distant layed with
