20th Commences with racing weather Wind
from the N W Squared the yards at 1 o'clock
Sun and good in towards the land Hoisted aboard
the Main-top-sail at 5 o'clock and lowered it
Boat and pulled Capt Baker ashore
to see if he could get any recruits for the
Ship Bowed up the yards and good off
shore Squared the yards at daylight and
stood on for the Land at 6 o'clock

from the E. Capt Baker came aboard
at 12 1/2 o'clock P.M. Braced up the main

from the N.E. Ship steering S.E. &
then employed in breaking out bar water

25th Commenced with squally weather
Wind & ship steering &

26th Commenced with Light winds from the E Ship steering S. W. Revised our the Fyee Islands at 6 o'clock A.M. bearing S. E. 1/2. S. longer distant.

2. & 3. commenced with a moderate breeze from
