Sires past the 24 hours fresh breeze from S. by E. by off and by for woods Middle and latter part the same by off and by Employed in getting off wood so Enos then 24 hours

Remarks On Board Sunday March 7th 1838

Sires past the 24 hours strong breeze ship lying off and on Employed in getting off water wood at 7. took up the (Boat) and steered N. by E. Middle part the same latter part pleasant so Enos then 24 hours
 Lat by Obs 32° 11' South
 Long by Chron 77° 14' West

Sires past the 24 hours fresh breeze from S. E. course N. by E. by compass Middle and latter part the same Employed in getting the (Boat) Boat saw fine fair weather equally so Enos then 24 hours

Sires past the 24 hours fresh breeze and squally from S. course N. by E. by compass past the (Boat) Boat Middle part strong breeze from S. E. course N. by E. by compass Employed in getting new (Boat) and other small jobs about deck latter part the same saw nothing of remark so Enos then 24 hours
