Remarks On Board Tuesday June 23<sup>rd</sup> 1838

First part strong breeze from N.W. ship of the wind N.E. by E. Employed boiling kibble part the same latter part heading S.W. saw the difference made whaling saw nothing new to Eneas then 24 hours  
Lat of Obs 35° 11' North  
Long of Chron 118° 52' West

Remarks On Board Wednesday June 24<sup>th</sup> 1838

First part strong breeze from N.W. steering S.E. at dusk hauld by the ponds to N.E. by N. Middle part the same latter part latched to S.W. saw nothing of remarks so Eneas then 24 hours  
Lat of Obs 35° 03' North  
Long of Chron 118° 37' West

Remarks On Board Thursday June 25<sup>th</sup> 1838

First part then 24 hours strong breeze from N.W. at 5 P.M. saw sperm whales going quick to S.E. towards S. boats at 6. struck one killed him and took him alongside at daylight cont. cutting at 8. finished heading of the wind to N.E. 2 sail in sight so Eneas then 24 hours  
Lat of Obs 34° 11' North  
Long of Chron 118° 27' West

Remarks On Board Friday June 26<sup>th</sup> 1838

First part then 24 hours strong breeze from N.W. ship of the wind to N.E. Employed in boiling kibble part the same latter part finished boiling one sail in sight boiling saw nothing so Eneas then 24 hours  
Lat of Obs 34° 16' North  
Long of Chron 118° 12' West

Remarks On Board Saturday June 27<sup>th</sup> 1838

First part light breeze from N.W. ship heading to N. at 5 P.M. no latched to S.W. Middle and latter the same saw 4 beach to under way so Eneas this day  
Lat of Obs 33° 53' North  
Long of Chron 118° 34' West

Remarks On Board Sunday June 28<sup>th</sup> 1838

First part then 24 hours strong breeze from N.W. heading N. by the wind one sail in sight kibble part latched to S.W. latter the same saw nothing of remarks so Eneas then 24 hours  
Lat of Obs 34° 23' North  
Long of Chron 118° West

Remarks On Board Monday June 28<sup>th</sup> 1838

First part strong breeze from N.W. latched to N. by the wind kibble part latched to S.W. latter part latched to N.W. Employed Coopering Oils to show saw nothing of remarks so Eneas this day  
Lat of Obs 34° 38' West  
Long of Chron 118° 23' West

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 29<sup>th</sup> 1838

First part then 24 hours light breeze from N.W. ship of the wind to N. at 6. latched to S.W. kibble part the same latter part latched to N. Employed showing down Oils in fore hold saw nothing of remarks so Eneas then 24 hours  
Lat of Obs 34° 28' North  
Long of Chron 118° 10' West

Remarks On Board Wednesday June 30<sup>th</sup> 1838

First part then 24 hours light breeze from N.W. heading to N. at 6. latched to S.W. kibble and latter the same saw nothing so Eneas then 24 hours  
Lat of Obs 34° 08' North  
Long of Chron 118° 01' West

Remarks On Board Thursday July 1<sup>st</sup> 1838

First part strong breeze from N.W. latched to N.W. Employed in ship deck kibble and latter the same weather clearing saw nothing of remarks so Eneas then 24 hours  
Lat of Obs 34° 10' North  
Long of Chron 118° 11' West

Remarks On Board Friday July 2<sup>nd</sup> 1838

First part strong breeze from N.W. latched to S.W. by the wind 4 sail kibble part latched to N.W. latter the same so Eneas this day  
Lat of Obs 34° 37' North  
Long of Chron 118° 35' West

Remarks On Board Saturday July 3<sup>rd</sup> 1838

First part strong breeze from N.W. saw 4 school of sperm whales going quick to wind towards lower S. boats at 5 P.M. struck 2 one boat got capsized over the whale at 7. took the whale alongside and took in sailed at daylight cont. cutting at 8. A.M. finished kibble sail heading to N.W. saw nothing to day so Eneas then 24 hours  
Lat of Obs 34° 48' North  
Long of Chron 118° 19' West
