First part strong breeze from N. W. steering S. E. at 4 P. M. saw the ship Clifforde Wagon phalizing business 3 boats at 5 P. M. shot & killed them and took them along side at 7 and took in sails for the ship at 8 P. M. saw nothing for Enos then 24 hours cutting

First part light breeze Employed cutting at 1 P. M. finished and started the works latter part heading N. N. E. Employed Boiling for Enos this day
