Birds, part light breeze from N. course S. of compass. Middle and latter part the same all sails set. Saw nothing of remark. So Ends then 24 hours

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 10th 1838
Birds, part light breeze from N. N. E. and pleasant course S. of E. by compass. Middle and latter part the same birds plenty from N. E. saw nothing of remark this day. So Ends then 24 hours

Long of Obs 116° 31' West

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 11th 1838

Birds, part fresh breeze from E. and squally with rain course S. of E. Middle and latter part the same squally with showers of rain. Saw nothing of remark. Employed in ships duty. So Ends then 24 hours

Remarks On Board Thursday August 12th 1838
Birds, part light breeze and squally from E. to N. E. weather clearing. Course S. of E. Middle and latter part course S. E. weather clearing. Saw 1 ship (Barber) N. W. Nothing more of remark. So Ends then 24 hours

Long of Obs 116° 04' West

Remarks On Board Friday August 13th 1838

Birds, part strong breeze from E. S. E. to S. E. ships by the wind to S. E. weather clearing. Middle part took a heavy squally from S. E. calms all hands and took in sails latter part moderate trade sails steering by the wind to E. S. E. wind from S. to S. W. So Ends then 24 hours
Lat of Obs 10° 54' North
Long of Obs 115° 44' West

Remarks On Board Saturday August 14th 1838
Birds, part light baffling breeze from S. to S. W. course S. of E. weather clearing. Middle part calms latter part light breeze from N. E. course S. of E. saw nothing of remark. So Ends then 24 hours

Birds, part fresh breeze from E. N. E. ships by the wind to S. E. Middle part the same latter part light breeze from E. to S. E. heading from S. S. E. to S. W. saw nothing of remark. So Ends then 24 hours

Long of Obs 114° 16' West

Remarks On Board Monday August 16th 1838
Birds, part light breeze and calms from E. to N. E. thick haze. Squalls hanging about the horizon. Middle and latter part squally with rain. So Ends then 24 hours

Long of Obs 113° 03' West

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 17th 1838

Birds, part strong breeze from S. ships by the wind to E. S. E. weather clearing. Middle part the same latter part breeze from E. by compass. Weather clear. Saw nothing of remark. So Ends then 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1° 11' North
Long of Obs 110° 39' West

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 18th 1838
Birds, part fresh breeze from S. S. E. to S. steering by the wind to E. weather clearing. Middle part the same latter part squally with rain heading E. S. E. by the wind. Saw nothing of remark. So Ends then 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1° 44' North
Long of Obs 109° 43' West

Remarks On Board Thursday August 19th 1838

Birds, part fresh breeze from S. heading E. S. E. by the wind. Weather clearing. Middle and latter part the same heading S. S. E. to S. so Ends this day

Long of Obs 105° 38' West

Remarks On Board Friday August 20th 1838
Birds, part strong breeze from S. heading E. S. E. by compass. Weather thick and squally. Middle and latter part heading E. S. E. to E. by S. saw nothing of remark this day. So Ends then 24 hours

Long of Obs 103° 26' West
