for sea Discharged four crew men and James Archer Boston
Boatmen Shipper S. Boatmen

Remarks On Board Saturday Sept 18th 1838

Went past Cape Ship ready for sea at 4 A.M. took our anchor
and stood out to sea for Enao this day

Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 19th 1838

Went past Cape Ship and ready heading up the Sound at 6.
P.M. went Malpelo Light 15 Bearing E. of compass Middle
and latter part working up for Payto the Sound in sight
for Enao then 20 hours
Lat 4° 45' S. 18° 30' West
Long 140° 30' West

Remarks On Board Monday Sept 20th 1838

Went past strong breeze from N.E. heading N.E. at 6 P.M.
tacked off Thine Cape Blanco 15 Sides Middle and latter
part working up for Payto for Enao then 20 hours

Remarks On Board Tuesday Sept 21st 1838

Went past strong breeze from N.E. at 5 P.M. came
to anchor in 8 fathoms water at the port of Payto
South America

Remarks On Board Wednesday Sept 22nd 1838

All hands Employed in washing ships and getting ready
for painting for Enao this day

Remarks On Board Thursday Sept 23rd 1838

This day painting Employed in painting ships and painting
ships out side and in One watch on liberty

Remarks On Board Friday Sept 24th 1838

This day One watch Employed painting ships the other
watch on shore on liberty

Remarks On Board Saturday Sept 25th 1838

This day One watch on shore on liberty the other employed
on Board for Enao this day

Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 26th 1838

This day One watch on shore on liberty

Remarks On Board Monday Sept 27th 1838

This day placed one watch on shore on liberty the other
One Boatmen and 2 men took Charles Ellis for four men

Remarks On Board Tuesday Sept 28th 1838

Went past fine pleasant weather One man Decatur Band
caught him again all hands on Board getting ready for
sea for Enao then 20 hours
Logg 16 Payto

Remarks On Board Wednesday Sept 29th 1838

Went past pleasant and all hands on Board at 2 P.M.
took our anchor and stood to sea the Capt remaining on
shore at 6 P.M. Payto Head (N.E. 25 miles) Sides
Course N. by compass Middle part strong trade from
N.E. latter part strong N. by compass weather thick
and haze saw Humphreys for Enao then 20 hours
Lat 4° 45' S. 18° 30' West
Long 140° 30' West
