Birds pass this day, light trades and pleasant breeze E. by S.
A compass Midland part the same latter part tacked to N. by N.
Employed in cooping with provisions saw nothing of remark
so ends this day

Long of Chron 84° 18' West

Remarks On Board Thursday Oct 14th 1838

Birds pass this day, light winds from S. heading N. by N. Employed
cooping with provisions and latter part light breeze from
S. heading to N. by N. light breeze from N. by N. some other
so ends this day

Long of Chron 84° 12' West

Remarks On Board Friday Oct 15th 1838

Birds pass this day, light trades from S. heading E. by S. saw
Blackbirds and 2 Midland parts heading S. by S. latter part
heading E. by S. saw finbacks nothing of remark
so ends this day

Remarks On Board Saturday Oct 16th 1838

Birds pass strong trades heading E. by E. and 6 tacked to N. by N.
Midland and latter part the same finbacks and Blackbirds
so ends this day

Remarks On Board Sunday Oct 17th 1838

Birds pass strong trades and breeze heading E. by the wind to
S. by N. Midland and latter part the same pass Blackbirds
and some weather thick and foggy so ends this day
Lat of Obs. 34° 38' South
Long of Chron 83° 36' West

Remarks On Board Monday Oct 18th

Birds pass strong trades from S. by S. to N. by N. saw
Blackbirds Midland and latter part heading E. by S. and
S. by S. Employed in boiling Blackfish saw finbacks and
so ends this day
Lat of Obs. 34° 21' North

Remarks On Board Tuesday Oct 19th 1838

Birds pass this day, strong trades heading to E. by N. saw
Banks heading to E. by N. Midland part tacked to N. by N.
A compass weather breeze saw Blackbirds and finbacks
so ends this day
Lat of Obs. 34° 53' South
Long of Chron 84° 25' West

Remarks On Board Wednesday Oct 20th 1838

Birds pass this day, strong trades and breeze ships of the wind to
S. by N. and S. by N. Midland part tacked to E. latter part steady
A compass weather thick and breeze saw nothing of remark
so ends this day
Lat of Obs. 34° 49' South
Long of Chron 83° 48' West

Remarks On Board Thursday Oct 21st 1838

Birds pass fresh trades steering N. by compass weather light and
nothing Midland part tacked to the wind to E. latter part the
same pass nothing of remark weather thick and rainy so
ends this day
Lat of Obs. 34° 49' South
Long of Chron 84° 38' West

Remarks On Board Friday Oct 22nd 1838

Birds pass this day, light trades and breeze ships of the wind to
E. by N. Midland part the same latter part steady N. by N.
A compass weather quite pleasant the first time for 10 days
so ends this day
Lat of Obs. 34° 51' South
Long of Chron 83° 38' West

Remarks On Board Saturday Oct 23rd 1838

Birds pass pleasant steering N. by E. saw Blackbirds at 6.
tacked to the wind to E. Midland part from back to E.
latter part heading E. by S. A compass saw nothing
so ends this day
Lat of Obs. 34° 30' South
Long of Chron 83° 36' West
