 Long of Obs 88. 51 West

 First part this day 24 hours fresh breeze ships by the wind to the
 E. weather thick and hazy Middle and latter parts ships by

Remarks On Board Sunday Nov 7th 1838

First part this day 24 hours from 9. kept off for white

 to N. by E. passed a bark sailing Middle part tacked to
 E. by N. latter tacked to N. by N. weather thick and foggy
 saw nothing so Ended this day

 Long of Obs 88. 17 West

First part this day 24 hours strong breeze ships by the wind to N. by N.
 1 mile in sight to the westward Middle part heading to E. by N.

 so Ended then 24 hours

Remarks On Board Wednesday Nov 10th 1838
 First part 24 hours strong breeze and clear heading to N. by N. at 2. P.M.
 saw 10 miles and Aberdeen distance bearing S. by N.
 and N. by N. 30 miles distant Middle part tacked to the
 E. latter part the same wind strong saw nothing to day
 so Ended this day
 Lat of Obs 1. 49 North
 Long of Obs 88. 16 West

Remarks On Board Thursday Nov 11th

First part this day 24 hours strong breeze ships by the wind to E. 1. sail
 in sight Middle and latter parts heading to West weather
 hazy saw nothing that looks like whales this day
 so Ended this day
 Lat of Obs 1. 42 North
 Long of Obs 88. 51 West

Remarks On Board Friday Nov 12th 1838
 First part strong breeze ships by the wind to N. by N. Spoke
 Ship (Jernard) Nov 31 Marches out 1000 lbs Green Middle
 part heading to E. by N. latter part tacked to N. by N. weather
 hazy so Ended this day
 Lat of Obs 1. 33 North
 Long of Obs 88. 25 West

Remarks On Board Saturday Nov 13th 1838

First part strong breeze and hazy ships by the wind to N. by N.
 Middle and latter parts heading to E. by N. saw nothing to day
 so Ended this day
 Lat of Obs 1. 33 North
 Long of Obs 88. 41 West

Remarks On Board Sunday Nov 14th 1838
 First part this day 24 hours strong breeze and hazy ships by the wind
 to E. by N. passed a bark sailing Middle part tacked to
 N. by N. latter tacked to N. by N. weather thick and foggy
 saw nothing so Ended this day
 Lat of Obs 1. 13 North
 Long of Obs 88. 36 West

Remarks On Board Monday Nov 15th 1838

First part this day 24 hours strong breeze steering off N. by N. at 6 hauls by the
 wind to E. by N. the wind S. by N. Middle part heading to
 E. by N. latter part steered E. by N. nothing seen with 8 am aloft
 so Ended this day
 No observation

Remarks On Board Tuesday Nov 16th 1838
 First part strong breeze from 9. steering off N. by N. Middle
 part heading E. by N. latter part steering N. by E. by compass
 weather hazy and foggy and wind strong saw nothing of
 remarks so Ended this day
 Lat of Obs 1. 14 North
 Long of Obs 88. 15 West
