First part this day light breezes and pleasant ships of the line to E. Middle part the same latter part saw the Coast of South America Capt. Blaney bearing E. S. E. miles and wind strong

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 4th 1839

First part this day strong breezes heading E. S. E. by compass saw ships to W. off shore at E. the land in sight S. miles and weather clear and latter part heading E. S. E. weather, breeze and wind strong

First part this day strong breezes heading E. S. E. saw (Blackfish) got 1. Middle part heading to W. S. W. saw a ship heading to W. S. W. latter part tack to E. S. E. weather pleasant

First part this day light breezes and pleasant ships of the line to E. Middle part tack to E. S. E. latter part thick and sailing in squalls ships heading E. S. E. saw nothing of remark

Remarks On Board Sunday June 9th 1839

First part this day light air and sailing heading E. S. E. by the wind Middle and latter part the same weather clear and wind strong saw Blackfish latter part got 2. Nothing more of note
End of the 24 hours

Remarks On Board Monday June 10th 1839

First part this day strong breezes ships of the line to E. S. E. Middle part the same latter part light breezes heading E. S. E. by compass Employers setting up shacks for water saw nothing of note

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 11th 1839

First part this day light breezes from E. S. E. heading E. S. E. by compass Middle part heading E. S. E. latter part the same Employers in boiling boiling Blackfish and setting up shacks saw nothing

Remarks On Board Wednesday 12th 1839

First part this day light breezes ships of the line to E. S. E. at 6 P. M. Calms Middle and latter part light breeze from E. S. E. by compass saw nothing of note

Long of Obs 84 31 West

Remarks On Board Thursday June 13th 1839

First part this day light breezes from E. S. E. steering E. S. E. at 1 P. M. saw the same heading E. S. E. 20 miles and 1/2 were ships off shore latter part tack to E. S. E. and stood in for St. James saw 2 sails on sight off shore St. James point bearing E. S. E. 20 miles and 1/2 End of the 24 hours
