Remarks On Board Friday June 14th 1839

First part pleasant and light breeze from N. West by compass at 3 P.M. come to anchor in the port of Pisco in 4 fathoms of water

Remarks On Board Saturday June 15th 1839

First part this day all hands employed in getting water weather rainy for some

Remarks On Board Sunday June 16th 1839

First part this day weather rainy all hands on board for some this day

Remarks On Board Monday 17th 1839

First part this day all hands employed in getting off wood and water arrived Bark Sacramento for some

Remarks On Board Tuesday 18th 1839

All hands employed in getting off wood and water weather rainy through the night for some

Remarks On Board Wednesday 19th 1839

This day finished getting off wood and water one watch on shore in liberty

Remarks On Board Thursday 20th June 1839

First part this day pleasant employed in painting ships one watch on shore in liberty

Remarks On Board Friday June 21st 1839

First part one watch on shore in liberty employed in taking on board potatoes

Remarks On Board Saturday June 22nd 1839

First part this day pleasant one watch on shore in liberty arrived ship James Lopez Kentucky 41 knots out 3 1/2 M. from San Mateo

Remarks On Board Sunday June 23rd 1839

First part this day pleasant one watch on shore on liberty Thomas Pickles post Captain James Kirkman Despatch Agent and others discharged sick

Remarks On Board Monday June 24th 1839

First part this day pleasant ship ready for sea detainee on account of Dealers

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 25th 1839

This day pleasant arrived Bark Orion 18 knots out 6 1/2 M. from ship ready sailing for some

Remarks On Board Wednesday June 26th 1839

First part this day fine pleasant weather shipped 4 men 2 more despatched home and four arrived Bark Hellena May

Remarks On Board Thursday June 27th 1839

First part pleasant with all on board at 10 M. took up anchor and stood out of the bay

Remarks On Board Friday June 28th 1839

First part light air working up for Pisco at 6 P.M. the same day 10 M. later ship off shore arrived pass the same later part taken in shore at Pisco in sight to Pisco L. Enos

Remarks On Board Saturday June 29th 1839

First part this day light air and calm at 6 P.M. took up ship off shore range in sight Middle pass the same later part P. Blackfield got 2. Steady 4 with light air Capt. Blanches J. E. Lead 33 miles for Enos this day

Remarks On Board Sunday June 30th 1839

First part this day light air from P.M. heading by the winds to P.M. J. E. Middle pass between to P.M. later part taken to P.M. of the same working up for Pisco at 12 M. from Pisco Hellena May J. E. of Pisco 33 miles
